

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Stanley Road Construction is committed to maintaining, and wherever possible, improving the quality of the environment, both for people working for the company and for the wider community.

Our activities are planned and performed to minimise environmental impact and to comply with legislative and contractual requirements. Planning seeks to make the most effective and efficient use of resources, prevent pollution and encourage employees to develop an ecologically sound approach to their work and lifestyle.

Stanley Road Construction will:

- Regularly monitor and review use and disposal of materials.
- Purchase materials and equipment in an environmentally friendly manner. Preference will be given to items produced in ways which cause least harm to the environment and, wherever practicable, create least waste
- Encourage the reuse and recycling of materials, where practicable and possible
- Encourage staff to distribute internal and external documentation electronically
- Provide sufficient training in environmental aspects of work, to ensure that staff are aware of the actions required to eliminate or minimise the impacts of those aspects.

We demonstrate our commitment by implementing an Environmental Management System which provides a framework for setting and review of environmental performance objectives and targets and meets the requirements of ISO 14001:2004 – Environmental Management System.

This policy is reviewed annually to ensure and improve its effectiveness in meeting legal requirements and planned environmental outcomes. It is communicated to staff at induction and is available to staff and other interested parties on the company web site.
